### APPROVAL OF SUPPLEMENTS

BCSS employees will receive a \$1000 supplement in a separate check issued on Friday, April 23.

- A half-time of 49% employee will receive \$500.
- All custodians will be included. We will provide funding for KBS Services and they will provide the supplement through their payroll process.
- We will be including substitute teachers, substitute bus drivers, substitute monitors, and substitute school nutrition workers who have provided service for a minimum number of days this year.
  - Any substitute with 100 days or more of service this year will receive \$1000
  - Any substitute with at least 50 days will receive \$500
  - Substitute supplements will be provided at the end of May to ensure accurate accounting of days served.

An additional supplement of \$500 was approved for November of 2021. We will use the same approach with this second round of supplements as we do with the first one.
