

**Tickets/Stadium Entry:** Entry to Stadium is 4:15:PM. **No re-entry will be permitted under any circumstances for students.** 


- Ticket Prices:

### Get a year of college tuition, books and fees for free!

ASCENT is a program through which you can get one free year of tuition, books and fees at UNC, Metro, or FRCC. To participate, students must complete at least 9 college credits by May of senior



year. AP scores (for tests taken during junior year) can count, as do CLEP scores. CLEP tests are 2 hour tests on a variety of subjects, and I can sign you up for these at no cost to you.

Interested 9th, 10th and 11th graders – start planning now by building concurrent enrollment, dual enrollment, and District Select classes into your schedule. I can help you with this. 12th graders there's still time to qualify! Please reach out.



## Who is Eligible for Busing?

Students are eligible for busing if they live outside the designated walk distance boundary for their neighborhood school. Walk distances are defined as follows:



- PK: 1.0 mile
- **K-5**: 1.5 miles
- 6-8: 2.0 miles
- 9-12: 2.5 miles

Eligibility may vary for school-specific programs. Students who open enroll in another school do not qualify for busing.

### How to Register for a Bus

Families must register their students to ride the bus via the Infinite Campus parent portal by July 1 at 5 p.m. New students should contact Transportation directly. Registration helps us plan bus routes effectively. For those who do not qualify, space-available seats may be applied for starting in July, but availability is not guaranteed. Registered students will receive their bus pass from their driver at the start of the school year. Note: University Hill, Community Montessori, and Pioneer students have different eligibility criteria.

### ¿Quién es Elegible para el Transporte Escolar?

Los estudiantes son elegibles para el transporte escolar si viven fuera del límite de distancia a pie designado para su escuela de vecindario. Las distancias a pie se definen de la siguiente manera:

• PK: 1.0 milla

• K-5: 1.5 millas

• 6-8: 2.0 millas

• 9-12: 2.5 millas

La elegibilidad puede variar según los programas específicos de la escuela. Los estudiantes que se inscriben en otra escuela no califican para el transporte escolar.

### Cómo Registrarse para el Autobús

Las familias deben registrar a sus estudiantes para usar el autobús a través del portal para padres de Infinite Campus antes del 1 de julio a las 5 p.m. Los estudiantes nuevos deben contactar directamente al Departamento de Transporte. La inscripción nos ayuda a planificar las rutas de autobús de manera efectiva. Para aquellos que no califiquen, se puede solicitar asientos disponibles a partir de julio, aunque la disponibilidad no está garantizada. Los estudiantes registrados recibirán su pase de autobús de su conductor al inicio del año escolar. Nota: Los estudiantes de University Hill, Community Montessori y Pioneer tienen criterios de elegibilidad diferentes.

### **Opciones de Transporte Alternativo**
