An ASI teacher will provide support to your child during the regularly scheduled school day. Based on your student's need, support will consist of multiple, focused, targeted instruction sessions that are:

- _____ Push in model where the ASI teacher works collaboratively with your child's teacher to provide student support during LAL or mathematics.

Throughout the year, your child's progress in meeting the skills expectations in the identified content areas will be monitored using LinkIt Form A, B and C Benchmark Exams, state testing and other assessments such as the Benchmark Assessment for Reading (BAS). If your student demonstrates the ability to meet the standards, their program requirements or ASI eligibility status will be re-evaluated, and you will be contacted. We strongly believe that family engagement is integral in supporting our students. Please plan to attend a Title I information session prior to your child's Back To School Night as well as Family Engagement presentations that you will be notified of throughout the year.
