Your Newline Interactive Board comes with the ability to connect with student Chromebooks.This allows students to present their Chromebook screen on the Newline Board for their class to see.

Starting a New Screen Sharing Session

1. On the Newline Board home screen, tap the "Screen Sharing" icon...



2. This is what you will see...



3. Have the student go to the website listed on the Newline Board (displaynote.com/join) from their Chromebook. They will need to enter the Session ID and their name, and then click "Connect".

4. Enter the PIN that is listed on the board and then click "Connect"...



5. On the Newline Board, you will now see the student's name appear in the list to the right. You can have up to 4 students connected to the board at one time (only one can be presenting at a time).

9. The student is now connected to the Newline Board and can present their screen to the class.

Disconnecting/Ending a Session

Sessions can be ended either by the student, or the teacher.

• <u>Teachers</u> can end a session by first tapping the "MENU" button in the lower left of the Newline screen, and then tapping the "Home" button.
