#### Student Fees, Fines, and Charges/Return of Property

The District shall provide a free public education. No fee shall be charged for any course where academic credit is awarded. A student may be charged a reasonable fee for any non-credit course or non-curricular activity such as an extracurricular activity, student activity, or membership in a voluntary club or association.

Fees may be required for the actual cost of breakage and of excessive supplies used in courses such as commercial education, industrial arts, music, performing arts, creative arts, consumer sciences, science or agriculture.

A student shall be responsible for the cost of replacing school materials or property lost or damaged due to negligence.

The Board delegates authority to the Superintendent to establish appropriate fees and procedures governing the collection of fees and procedures to guide building principals in determining when a fee may be waived in cases of financial hardship. The Superintendent shall make annual reports to the Board regarding fee schedules and fees waived.

*As a condition of graduation or issuance of an official transcript, the District requires all fees incurred by a student to be satisfied and all property of the District to be returned.*
