Dear Friends,

It brings me great joy to welcome all our St. Agnes catechists, students, and families to our new catechism year. The term "Catechism" which comes from a Greek word that means "to teach," is vital to all of us because it teaches us the foundation of our Catholic faith.

Catechism's divine purpose is to deepen our relationship with Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit drawing us closer to God. Catechism focuses on four main pillars:


- 1) The Creed (Faith what the Church believes)
- 2) The Sacraments & The Sacred Liturgy (what the Church celebrates)
- 3) Life in Christ The Commandments (how the Church lives its faith rooted in the image and teachings of Jesus)
- 4) Prayer (what the Church prays, how to talk to and connect with God.)

"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

~ <u>Matthew 22:19-20</u>

Jesus himself commanded all of us to become missionaries evangelizing the word of the Lord, and Catechism is a direct answer to that call. Our dedicated volunteer catechists generously share their time and hearts, imparting valuable lessons of faith to our students, enriching them spiritually and morally.

But it is important to note that ultimately, the catechists that carry the MOST influence on faith formation of these children are their own PARENTS. Spiritual education and growth begin and end at home every single day. Through their own actions, parents serve as daily examples of how their kids should live their faith and the kind of people they should be. Shaping the future of our children to be good and faithful people is the greatest responsibility that both parents and the Church share. I am confident, that together, with God's grace and guidance we will succeed.
