Amendment 4

BALLOT TITLE: Amendment to Limit Government Interference with Abortion

BALLOT SUMMARY: No law shall prohibit, penalize, delay, or restrict abortion before viability or when necessary to protect the patient's health, as determined by the patient's healthcare provider. This amendment does not change the Legislature's constitutional authority to require notification to a parent or guardian before a minor has an abortion.

WHY FLORIDIANS SHOULD VOTE NO ON AMENDMENT 4

Amendment 4 would enshrine UNREGULATED ABORTION in our state constitution, making Florida one of the MOST PRO-ABORTION states in the nation. The amendment language is MISLEADING, and its proposed outcomes are DANGEROUS

- PUTS WOMEN AT RISK: Amendment 4 would jeopardize existing laws and prohibit new ones that voters on both sides of the abortion issue support, including health and safety laws that protect women.
- ALLOWS SECOND AND THIRD TRIMESTER ABORTIONS: Though not defined in the amendment, "viability" is defined in Florida law as the stage of development when the life of a fetus is sustainable outside the womb (Ch. 390.011(15)), generally accepted to be 22-24 weeks of pregnancy, or about 6 months.
- CREATES A BROAD "HEALTH" LOOPHOLE: "Patient's health" is not defined in the amendment, allowing post-viability, extremely late-term abortions for treatable, temporary health concerns. Emotional health would justify an abortion when a child could survive outside the womb.
- **WEAKENS MEDICAL DOCTOR REQUIREMENT:** "Healthcare providers" not just physicians could determine if an abortion is "necessary" to protect the mother's "health." Even some employees of abortion clinics, such as nurses and counselors, could approve lateterm abortions.
- **ELIMINATES PARENTAL CONSENT:** While preserving parental notification in our state constitution (Article X, Section 22), the amendment would invalidate the current law that requires parental consent for a minor to have an abortion (Ch. 390.01114(5)), making abortion the only medical decision for which parents have no say.

PASTOR'S CORNER CORNER TO STATUTORY



Reflections From Our Pastor

Sept. 8th, 2024

Dear Friends,

You might have heard about Florida Amendment 4, which will appear on Florida's November 2024 ballot. If you have not, I urge you to be informed about Amendment 4, a misleading and dangerous proposal that would legalize abortion up to full term, prohibiting all restrictions on abortion before viability, eliminate parental consent, and create a broad exception that any "healthcare provider" could exploit to allow abortion up to birth.

As confirmed Catholics we are to witness in an increasingly secularized world that God matters and because God matters, human beings, created in God's own image and likeness, including the unborn, matter as well. By insisting that every human being matters, we bring to public policy debates on issues of human dignity, justice and peace, an understanding of the human person that, while founded on the Christian Scriptures, is also accessible to human reason.

Even those who do not agree with the Church teaching that human life begins at conception should find reasons to oppose this amendment. The amendment, for example, would effectively overturn or seriously jeopardize common-sense state laws that have regulated abortion for years. These include basic health and safety requirements for clinics where abortions are performed, requiring a physician to perform abortions, informed consent requirements, laws limiting public funding of abortion, and parental consent requirements before a minor's abortion.

As Catholics we believe that human life is sacred, and that the dignity of the human person is the foundation of a moral vision of society. In urging a No vote on Amendment 4, we wish to protect not only the unborn child – the weakest, most innocent and defenseless among us – but we also seek to protect countless women from the harms of abortion. Unborn children matter – and so do their mothers. Our Respect Life Ministry with its Pregnancy Assistance Centers helps provide women with life affirming alternatives to abortion and compassionately offer counseling and access to healing for those who have regretted a past abortion.


Catholic teachings on the rights and dignity of every human being from conception to natural death, stand in stark contrast to a tendency in our world to define classes or categories of people as "problems" and thus "dehumanize" them. Such reductive thinking led to the successive genocides of the 20th century and rationalizes the continued killing of the unborn. Last year, there were more than 83,000 abortions in Florida alone! These are 83,000 reasons why all Floridians should reject Amendment 4 and vote a resounding "no!"
