



Name that Book Club is an exciting reading club in Klein ISD

4th and 5th grade students are invited to participate and can begin reading from [this list](#) of 20 books. Klein ISD librarians have specially selected these books to represent a variety of genres and topics. Some are classics, some are newly published, and some have even won major children's literary awards!

We will have an introductory meeting on Sept. 25 from 3:45-4:15 for any student who returns the permission slip. Before fall break, we will meet on Monday during the school day to review the books. Students will read the books on their own at home and at school. After fall break, we will meet once a week after school on Tuesdays. We will read and participate in activities to prepare for the district-wide "Name that Book" competition. Once we know how many students are interested in joining, more information will be shared.

Frank expectations for Name That Book Club:

- **Attendance** - members must attend every practice after school on Tuesdays. 2 unexcused absences and a conference will be scheduled to determine eligibility.
- **Conduct** - members must be on their best behavior during practice. A discipline note will be sent if a child is having behavior problems and dismissal from the club will be strongly considered.
- **Competition** - members that are selected for a team must be available for district competition on Feb. 5th and March 1st.
- **Grade Policy** - members must maintain a "70" or above on academics and at least an "S" in conduct
- **Commitment** - members must commit the full time - both fall and spring
