#### Intro to Portraiture 3 weeks

**Mondays, Oct 14 – 28, 7:00 - 9:30 pm**  
With a focus on facial proportions and features, this class will explore the human portrait through drawing and color. The history of portraiture will be discussed along with a look at portraits in a contemporary context. Live portrait modeling and picture references will be utilized. The goal is to give students needed skills to understand and draw faces with confidence. *Note: Materials fee \$9. Prerequisite: Recommended—Drawing & Painting class or knowledge of basic drawing skills.*

#### Drawing & Painting Studio 7 weeks

**Mondays, Oct 21 – Dec 9, 6:00 - 8:30 pm**  
If just beginning, students will benefit from individual guidance through a variety of skill-building projects. More advanced participants can expand their basic skills in a creative support system. Both dry and water-based materials will be explored. All levels welcome. *Note: Materials list will be discussed first day of class or bring desired supplies. No class Nov 25.*

#### Printmaking Intro 4 weeks

**Wednesdays, Oct 23 – Nov 13, 6:00 - 8:30 pm**  
This course will teach the fundamentals of printmaking. Different printmaking techniques will be explored including relief, intaglio, monotype, and more. In addition to hand-pressing tools, our etching press will be put to use for various printing methods. With the ability to create multiples, printed images can be framed, added to journals, and gifted. Newcomers to printmaking and those looking to explore new printing techniques are encouraged to join! *Note: Materials fee \$14.*

#### Metalsmithing Intro 3 weeks

**Tuesdays, Nov 5 – 19, 6:00 - 9:00 pm**  
Using two metals of antiquity—copper and brass—learn basic metallurgical skills to cut, saw, and hammer simple shapes. Different ways of creating surface textures with a variety of tools will then be shown. With a wide selection of beads, findings, and components, participants will then be taught to finish, polish, and assemble final pieces. Perfect for making a pair of earrings, pendant, or ornamental key fob for yourself or as a unique gift. *Note: Materials fee \$45.*

#### Artistic Handmade Journals 5 weeks

**Thursdays, Nov 7 – Dec 12, 6:30 - 8:30 pm**  
Are you wracked with indecision about finding the perfect notebook for your poems, doodles, or musings? Look no more! That perfect journal is going to be the awesome handmade one that you'll design in this class! Students will learn several types of bookbinding including Japanese four hole, pamphlets, and classic hardcover case bindings. If you are able to part with one, they also make wonderful gifts! *Note: Materials fee \$12. No class Nov 28.*

#### Fine Silver Clay Jewelry 3 weeks

**Thursdays, Dec 5 – 19, 6:00 - 9:00 pm**  
Never thought you could actually create real silver jewelry? Well, think again! This kiln-fired clay turns into 100% silver once heated, enabling the ability to create truly striking and unique jewelry. Learn the basics of working with metal clay to design pieces and incorporate surface textures. Create a minimum of 3 to 4 pure silver pieces such as earrings, pendants, charms, and more. Then start accessorizing in your unique style! *Note: First day is mandatory. Materials fee \$50.*

#### Fused Glass Wind Chimes 2 weeks

**Tuesdays, Oct 8 & 22, 6:00 - 9:00 pm**  
Are you mesmerized by sound of wind chimes? If so, how about making your own! Learn fundamentals of design, glass cutting, and kiln fusing to create one with stunning colors! Week one will be for making chimes ready for firing. Week two will be assembling the fired pieces, with a choice to add elements of beads, found objects, or personal trinkets. You will leave with a beautiful wind chime to grace your home, porch, or garden. *Note: Materials fee \$35. Pieces take two weeks to fire.*

#### Fused Glass Ornaments 1 day

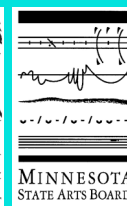
#### Ornaments! 1 day
