## District to Host Community Information Sessions in Advance of November Referendum

**GREEN BAY, WI – September 17, 2024** – The Green Bay Area Public School District Board of Education has approved a \$183 million facilities referendum question to be added to the November 5th ballot. Members of the community are invited to attend community information sessions to learn more about the referendum.

The November 2024 Referendum enhances safety and security at secondary schools; addresses deferred maintenance projects at several elementary schools (HVAC, fire alarm and electrical systems, roofs, ADA compliance issues, etc.); and provides equitable, efficient and appropriate learning environments for students and staff at the consolidated schools.

The District will have paid off a significant portion of the November 2022 Referendum allowing an opportunity for the District to borrow funds, while maintaining the current mill rate, and improving our students' educational experiences.
