WHAT WE'RE LEARNING

Math: I can recognize volume as an attribute of solid figures. I can determine the total volume to solve problems. I can explore the dimensions of all possible rectangular prisms given a total number of cubic units.

Reading: I can determine the main ideas of a text and explain how they are supported by key details. I can summarize a text.

Writing: I can use different writing prompt to create and write an narrative story.

Science: I can obtain, evaluate, and communicate information to group organisms using scientific classification procedures. I can develop a model that illustrates how animals are sorted into groups (vertebrate and invertebrate) and how vertebrates are sorted into groups (fish, amphibian, reptile, bird, and mammal) using data from multiple sources.
