WHAT WE'RE LEARNING

Math: I can write, interpret, and evaluate numerical expressions within authentic problems.

I can write, interpret, and evaluate simple numerical expressions involving whole numbers with or without grouping symbols to represent actual situations.

Reading: I can compare and contrast characters, settings, or events in a story.
I can determine the meaning of metaphors and similes.

Writing: I can develop an informational topic with facts, definitions, concrete details, quotations, or other information and examples related to the topic.

Social Studies: I can define cattle trails and their role in the late 19th century.
