

Read and write whole numbers using base-ten numerals, number names, and expanded form.

Standard Form: 456,843

Expanded Form: $400,000 + 50,000 + 6,000 + 800 + 40 + 3$

Base-ten numerals: 4 hundred thousands + 5 ten thousands + 6 thousands + 8 hundreds + 4 tens + 3 ones

*Base-ten numerals is also known as "Unit Form."

Number Names: four hundred fifty-six thousand, eight hundred forty-three

*Number Names is also known as "Word Form" or "Written Form."

Hundred Thousands	Ten Thousands	Thousands	Hundreds	Tens	Ones
4	5	6	8	4	3
