Student Arrival & Dismissal Reminders

As safety is our top priority, please be sure to use the drop off lane appropriately each day for arrival and dismissal. Please view the video below to learn more about our procedures.

A few important things to note:

- Please remain in your vehicle when using the drop off lane. Nelson staff will help your child to walk safely into the building. Please do NOT park your car in the drop off lane.
- The parent drop off lane is meant to be a *single* lane of cars. Please do not pull up next to cars in the lane to drop off students this is unsafe for your child and other families.
- Please do not block the bus lane at any time or pull up near the crosswalk to drop off your child. This creates a hazardous situation for all.
- Please do not make a u-turn to head south on Ozanam after dropping off your child. Please proceed north and turn left onto Park to exit.






