II. Appointment of Officers-In accordance with Article VII of the School Council Bylaws Judge Veal recommended Ms. Geni Reed as Chairperson, all were in favor and Ms. Reed accepted. III. State of the School Presentation-Principal Thompson-A handout containing demographic breakdown, behavioral data, current Lexile scores, and MAP proficiency comparisons was distributed and explanations given in regards to the data. UGM is striving to close any gaps that have or may get in the way of students reaching their full potential while also holding students to the highest standard. PBIS (positive behavioral intervention supports) are being used. Mr. Thompson, along with grade level AP's have all had conversations with students regarding being present, purposeful, and powerful. "Getting Back to our Why" was presented to show how the past couple of years has affected everyone and how it is necessary that we get back to providing equitable opportunities, engagement and experiences for all students.

IV. 90 Day Plan Presentation, CSIP Goals-Principal Thompson-Teacher instructional practice will follow the I Do (focused instruction), We Do (guided instruction), We Do (collaborative learning), and You Do It (independent learning) gradual release modeling.

V. Open Forum-Parent Needs, Concerns; School Needs, Concerns-Ms. Matthews suggested holding a virtual parent town hall meeting sharing the state of the school information. Ms. Reed concurred.
