Congratulations! You and your student have elected to enroll in one or more high school courses for Carnegie credit. Please review the information below regarding final grade requirements and how your child’s high school transcript will be impacted by the completion of the course(s). Please complete and return a copy of this form to the front office no later than **August 6, 2024**. Please keep one copy for your records.

- Students must earn a final grade of 70% or higher both semesters to receive Carnegie credit for the course at the end of the year.
- By the end of October, the principal may determine that your student be dropped from the course based on their academic performance. Parents/students may also decide to drop the course based on the student’s performance no later than the end of October.
- If the parents/student decide to drop the course during 1st semester, the student will be placed in the regular grade level course. The student’s grade at the time of the schedule change will be transferred to the new course in which the student will be enrolled for the remainder of the semester.
- If the student is enrolled in the course on December 1, the student must complete the remainder of 1st semester as well as the 2nd semester course and will not be able to drop the course, regardless of performance or grade.
- If the student is enrolled in the course on December 1, the final grade for each semester will be posted on the high school transcript, regardless of the final grade and will be calculated into the student’s high school GPA.
- Students enrolled in Honors Algebra I on or after December 1 will take the End-of-Course Milestones assessment which will count as 20% of the final grade for 2nd semester. These students will also be required to take the Math 8 End-of-Grade Milestones assessment.
- Honors Algebra I, Honors Geometry, Honors Physical Science, and Honors Spanish I will all receive a 0.5 weighted grade point.
