Nassau Community College (NCC)'s Partnership with Baldwin High School is an exciting opportunity for high school seniors to earn college credits while experiencing college life! The unique and innovative collaboration allows Baldwin High School students to take college-level courses **directly on the NCC campus** while also fulfilling their New York State high school graduation requirements.

Baldwin UFSD is currently the only school district on Long Island to have such a partnership and it is part of our commitment to ensuring every student graduates *future ready!* While on campus, Baldwin High School students are integrated into classes along with other NCC students. Seniors will also fulfill their senior year graduation requirements of English, Government, Economics, PE, Math, Science, as well as an elective course related to their interested field of study while enrolled in the NCC program.

The NCC Program is open to *all* students who meet requirements and is not based on GPA or standardized test scores.

- Earn up to **36 college credits** from NCC during senior year of high school.
- Interact with college faculty, staff, and other students on campus.
- Participate in NCC clubs and other extra-curricular activities offered by the college.
- Receive an official NCC academic transcript.
- Choose **electives** from full college course catalog with the help of school counselor.
- Receive transportation to and from the high school, if needed.
- Still be able to participate in high school sports and extra-curricular activities.



## WHY ENROLL?

- Get the full college experience and be better prepared for the future:

- Reduce college tuition costs and fees, which continue to rise.

## PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Students must meet eligibility requirements and be approved by their high school counselor for admission into the program.

- Must be a senior.
- Should be prepared to commit to the college's level of educational instruction.

## APPLICATION PROCESS

- There is a \$55 application fee (check should be made out to NCC).
- Prior to applying, students must consult with their school counselor for approval to be considered.
- First-time NCC students will need to complete the NCC High School Enrichment Admissions Application (paper-copy only). Directions on completing the application can be provided by your school counselor. Students must complete all required fields in the application.
- Once the submission process is complete, the Baldwin High School student will receive an NCC ID# to be used for registration and other activities with the college.
