



Sunscreen Protocol

Clebune I.S.D. wishes to encourage students to protect themselves from the sun. One way of doing this is to use sunscreen at the appropriate time. If a student plans to use sunscreen at school, parents are asked to:

1. Provide sunscreen for school use. The sunscreen must be:
 - a. Marked with the child's name.
 - b. Replenished by the parents as needed.
2. The sunscreen product will be stored in the child's book bag or other location designated by the teacher.
3. The child must be able to apply his or her sunscreen. (Grades 1-12)
4. Children in grades 1-12 will take responsibility for determining when to use sunscreen during the school day. Parents should instruct their children as to when to apply sunscreen.
5. For Pre-K and kindergarten parents: You are asked to apply sunscreen at home before a typical school day. If the school day is extended for your child (i.e.- a day field trip or extended day use) you are asked to:
 - a. Discuss with your child's teacher if your child is too young and unable to apply his/her sunscreen.
 - b. If it is considered necessary for teachers/staff to assist, sunscreen will be applied to the face, neck, arms, hands, and lower legs, to minimize or prevent sunburn.

You are asked to sign this form to acknowledge you have received the letter about the school's approach to sun safety.
