### **Position Description:**

St. Mark's Cathedral School is seeking an engaging, dynamic, and innovative Spanish teacher to join the department as a part-time faculty member. This part-time faculty member will be responsible for designing and implementing Preschool and Lower School Spanish courses.

### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Teacher within the curricular sequence of Preschool and 4th grade Spanish;
- Support and further enhance the department's high expectations for academic performance, intellectual inquiry, and personal growth for all students in each course;
- Lead Global Language colleagues in designing and implementing flexible, student-centered lesson planning reflective of best practices;
- Facilitate hands-on exploration, student collaboration and problem solving; integrate student-centered pedagogical practices into the curriculum;
- Create meaningful partnerships with parents and families, including regular communications through school-supplied online tools, emails, and phone calls.

### **Requirements:**

- A Bachelor's degree in Spanish or education-related field and/or native/heritage speaker; Master's degree strongly preferred;
- Minimum 3-5 years of teaching experience preferred;
- Proficiency in digital educational technologies;
- Experience with Google Workspace for Education (preferred);
- Enthusiasm for professional development;
- Committed to accommodating a diverse community of learners.

- Uses student-centered teaching methodologies and other research-based practices;
- Interested and experienced in leading curriculum refinement and collaborative professional development within a department;
- Confident and comfortable leading peers, particularly with designing creative, flexible lesson plans;
