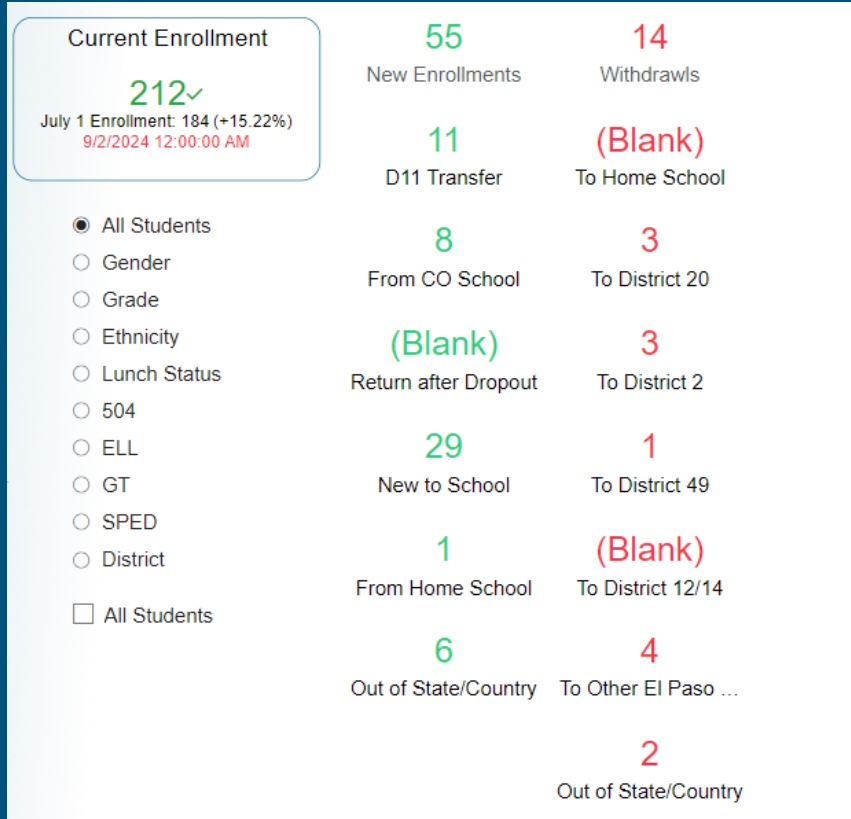

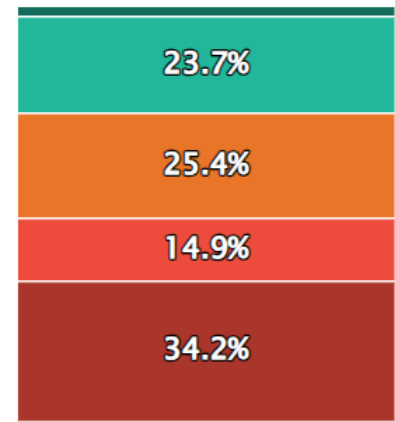

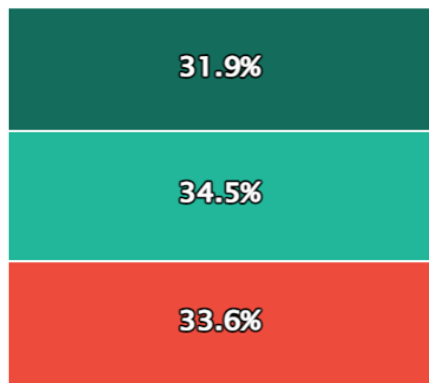

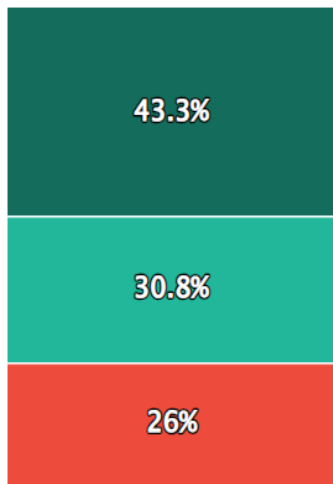

Star Reading Current Student Growth Percentile (SGP) ⓘ

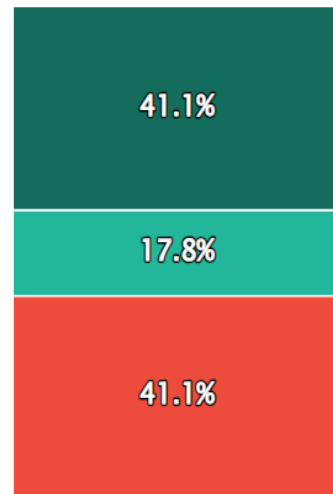

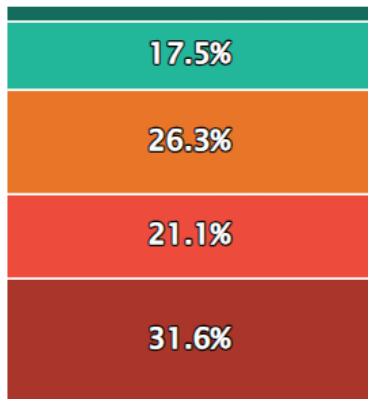

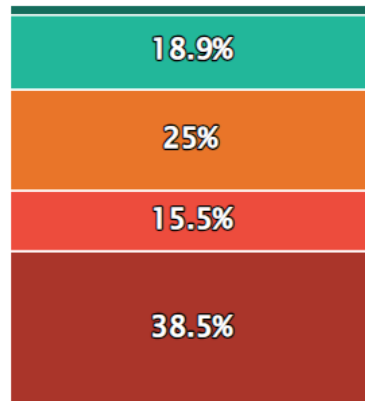

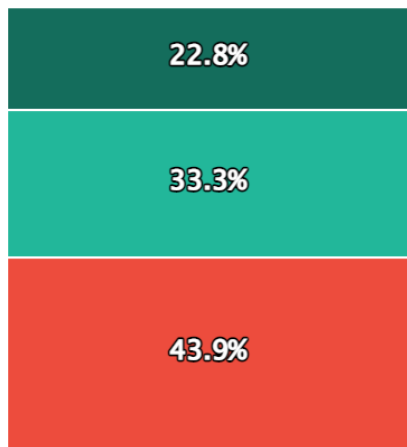

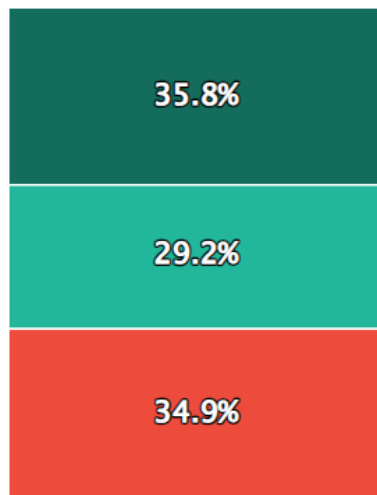

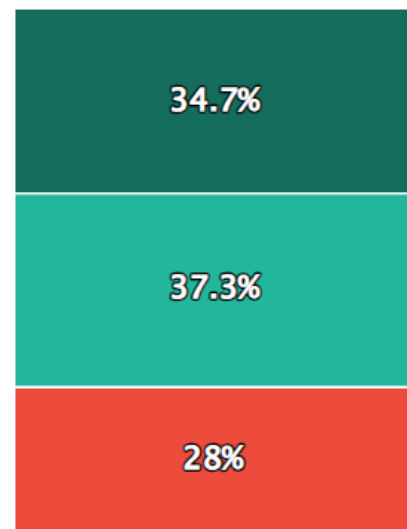

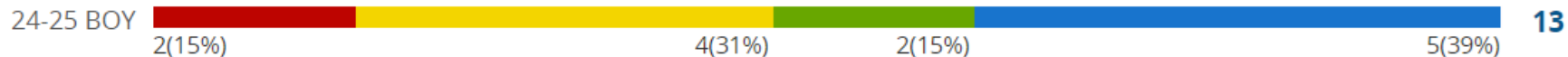

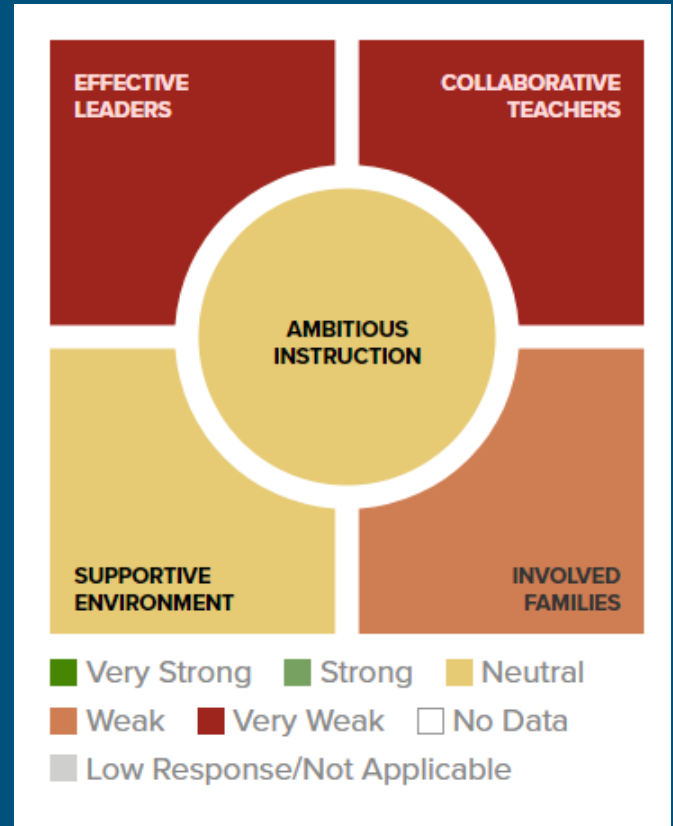
