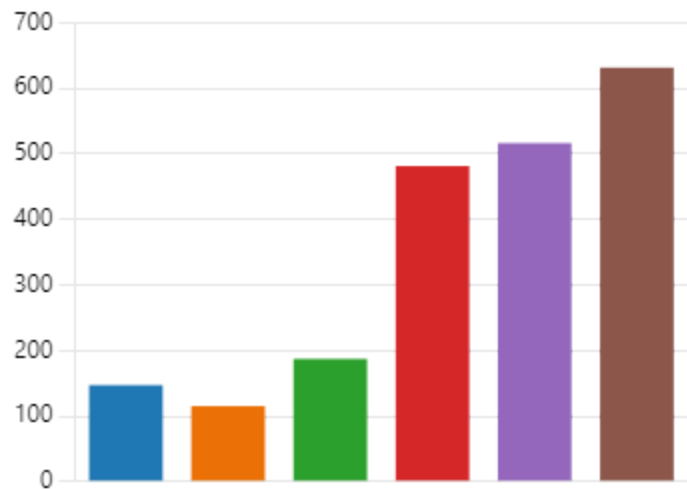

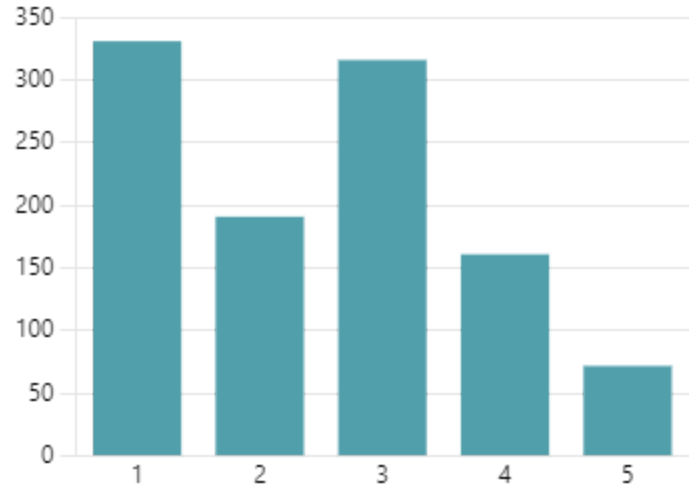

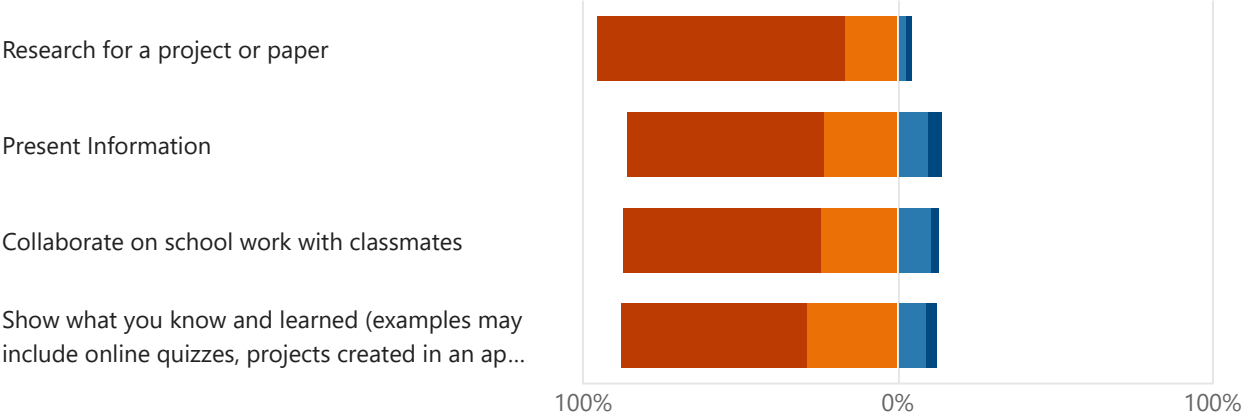
8. When working on a project or assignment, how likely are you to use technology to...

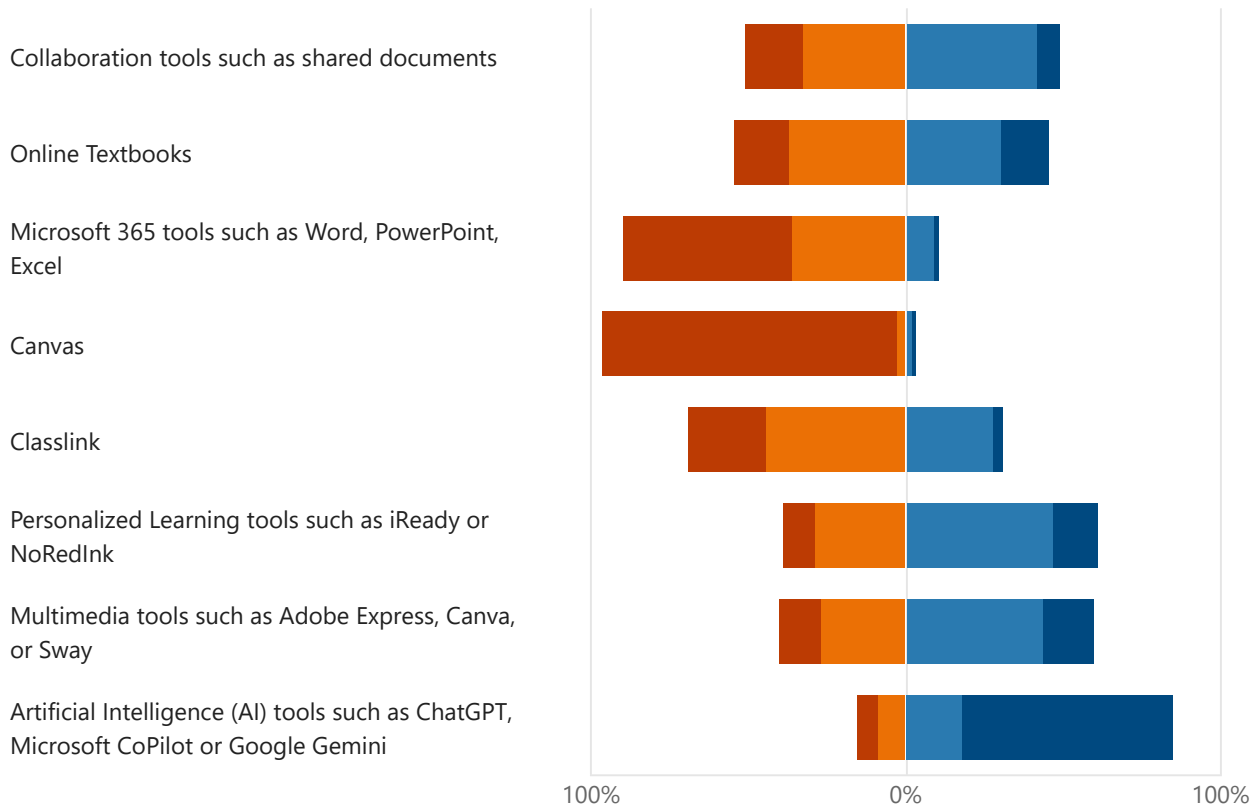
9. How comfortable are you using technology resources to...

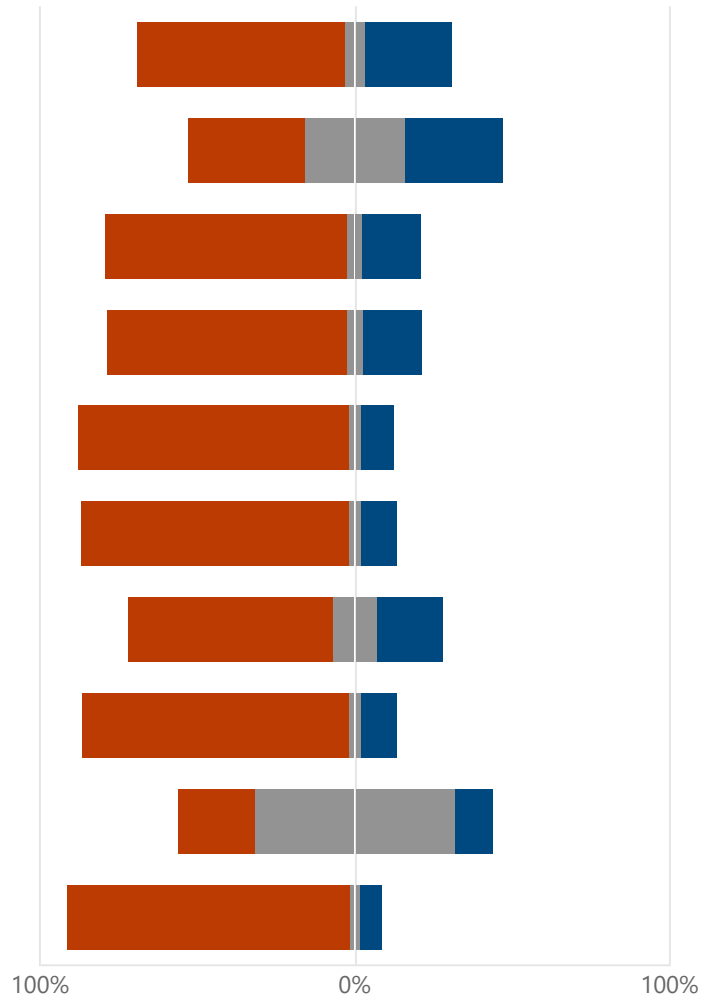

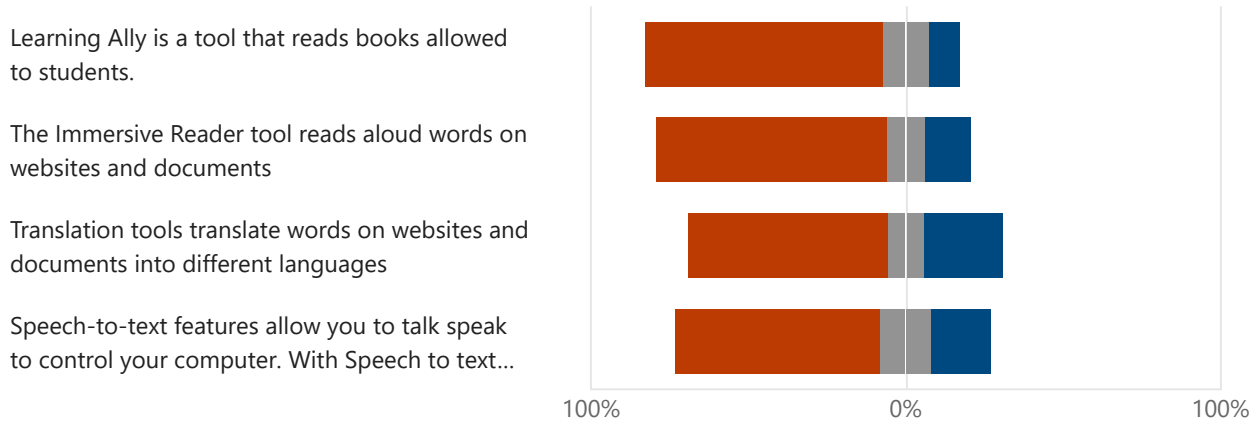
