



Welcome to 5th Grade!

This will be my fourth year teaching 5th grade at CVE and it is going to be a very exciting year! We have adopted a new science and SEL curriculum this year! Our daily schedule will consist of three main cores and enrichment. Core I will be our reading core, Core II will be math, and Core III will be science and writing. We will have library time every Thursday this year starting the second week of school.

Reading, Math, and Writing assignments will be presented in packets and on the computer. Reading and writing packets will be due weekly and math packets will be due at the end of each chapter. Daily assignments that are not completed in class must be taken home as homework the day that they are assigned and returned to school the following school day.

Homework packets are sent home every Thursday and the previous homework packet needs to be signed by an adult and turned in to be scored the same day. The focus of the weekly homework packet is math fact practice, cursive, spelling, and reading fluency. New reading packets are assigned every Monday. Every Monday you will receive a new weekly reading packet and the previous reading packet is collected. This packet will be completed in class each week. If you are unable to complete daily work it needs to be completed as homework and returned the next school day. A new math lesson is assigned every day in the math unit packet or online. Daily math is homework if it is not completed in class.

As 5th graders you will be developing 5 paragraph essays over the course of three weeks. Writing lessons are assigned on the first day of each reading module and are due on the last day of the reading module. Writing must be completed in class or as homework in order to be prepared for the following class day.

Our class website is a great resource for you to find material covered in class and all of the websites that we use in class. Epic, Xtra Math, IXL, HMH Into Reading & Science, Big Ideas Math, Google Classroom, and Google Suites will be the main websites/platforms we will be working with each week.

## 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Weekly Work and Login Information

### Daily Assignments and Homework

Listed are the daily assignments that your 5<sup>th</sup> grader should complete in reading, writing, and math. Daily assignments that are not completed in class must be taken home as homework the day that they are assigned and returned to school the following school day. Please check in with your students daily to help keep them on track.

**Homework:** Homework packets are sent home every Thursday. The previous homework packet needs to be signed by an adult and turned in to be scored on Thursday. The focus of the weekly homework packet is math fact practice, cursive, spelling, and reading fluency.

**Reading:** New reading packets are assigned every Monday. Every Monday students receive a new weekly reading packet and the previous reading packet is collected. This packet will be completed in class each week. Incomplete daily work is homework and needs to be returned the next school day. Social Studies and Science are integrated into the district adopted reading curriculum.

**Math:** A new math lesson is assigned every day. Daily math is homework if it is not completed in class. When all daily math activities are completed at the end of the unit they become a “Math Expert”! At the end of each math unit, students that completed all assignments will receive one wing for each assignment.

**Writing:** 5th graders will be developing 5 paragraph essays over a three week writing process. Each day a new writing lesson will be introduced that is taught in correlation with the reading curriculum. Students must complete their writing in class or as homework in order to be prepared for the following class day.
