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### SCHOOL OVERVIEW

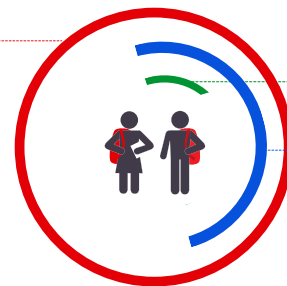
Casablanca American School (CAS), established in 1973, is an N-12 university preparatory school which embraces an American system of education and offers an International Baccalaureate Full Diploma Program in grades 11 and 12. The Upper School includes students from grades 7-12. CAS is the first International Baccalaureate school in North Africa and has been offering the Full IB Diploma since 1987.

### IB DIPLOMA PROGRAM

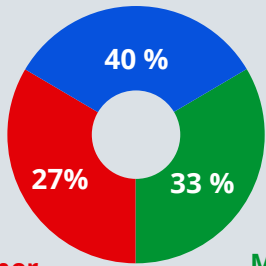
Starting in Grade 11, all Casablanca American School students are enrolled in the 2-year IB Diploma program.

### CLASS RANK AND GPA

**CAS does not provide class rank, nor does it compute cumulative GPA.**

Colleges are encouraged to base their admission decision on the Forecasted IB Grades.

### GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students must pass all courses in grades 9-12 in order to receive a CAS diploma, which is the equivalent of an American high school diploma; IB diploma also conferred based upon exam results.

### FORECASTED IB GRADES

The IB program offered at CAS is a two-year program terminating with the IB Exams in May of the second year. When reflecting students' performance in the program up to the time of the university application (fall of grade 12), we prefer to refer to the IB Predicted Grades as "Forecasted IB Grades." To the best of our knowledge, the Forecasted IB Grades represent the grades a student can achieve on the IB examinations in May.
