1. The Pottsville Area School District was awarded a three-year Botvin LifeSkills Training (LST) Middle School grant, starting in Fall 2022. DHH Lengel Middle School will receive training, technical assistance, curriculum materials and sustainability resources to provide a research-based program to promote mental health and positive youth development. The program effectively reduces substance abuse and other high-risk behaviors through development of communication, decision-making and social skills. The LST program will provide a foundation for the Project Toward No Drug Abuse program that is used in the Pottsville Area High School health class.
