

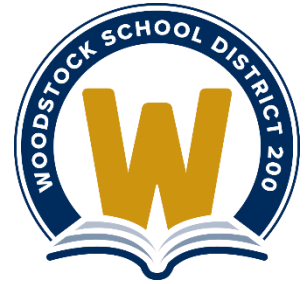

Blue Streaks to host Military Appreciation Night Sept. 27

The Woodstock High School Blue Streaks have designated the Sept. 27 home football game as a day to honor servicemen and women with a Military Appreciation Night at Larry Dale Field.

Veterans or active military members who register can receive free admission to the game, a meal ticket and be honored prior to the 7:30 p.m. varsity game against the Richmond-Burton Rockets.

Servicemen and women and veterans who plan to attend the game are asked to fill out this registration form <https://forms.gle/dwEJ81tT7supjvzQA> to be placed on a list for the free items and to have their names read aloud.

Blue Streaks Head Football Coach Mike Brasile said the team was looking for a way to honor area veterans and military members for their sacrifice to our country.

The Woodstock VFW Color Guard, which includes former Streaks football coach Greg “Woody” Walkington, will also be displaying its flags.

In addition to the free admission and recognition, the team is also selling “Support Our Troops” T-shirts for \$20. Half of the proceeds from T-shirt sales will be donated to the Woodstock VFW Post 5040 while the other half will be presented to the Wounded Warrior Project.
