

Privacy Statement

Ingenuity Charter School is committed to protecting the privacy of our students, parents, staff, and visitors. This Privacy Statement outlines our practices regarding the collection, use, and protection of information collected through our website.

Information We Collect

- **IP Addresses:** We automatically collect IP addresses (the unique string of numbers that identifies the device you use to access the internet) for site security and to understand how our site is used.
- **Cookies:** Our website may use cookies to enhance the user experience. Cookies are small files stored on your device that help us recognize repeat visitors and track site usage. The use of cookies is an industry standard and is used on most websites.
- **Personal Information:** We may collect personal information such as your name, email address, phone number, and any other information you provide when you fill out forms or surveys on our website or contact us via email or through another communication channel.

How We Use the Information

- **Enhancing User Experience:** We use IP addresses and data collected from cookies to understand how our website is used and to improve its functionality and content.
- **Communication:** We may use your contact information to respond to inquiries, provide updates, and communicate important information.
- **Compliance and Security:** We use data to ensure the security of our website and to comply with legal obligations.

Third-Party Service Providers

We may share information with trusted third-party service providers who assist us in operating our website and conducting our school activities. These providers are

bound by confidentiality agreements and are not permitted to use the information for any purpose other than to perform services on our behalf.

Information Sharing and Disclosure

We do not sell your personal information. However, we or our third-party service providers may disclose your personal information if required by law or if necessary to:

- Respond or participate in the judicial process;
- Protect the security or integrity of the website, mobile application, or online service;
- Ensure legal or regulatory compliance or take precautions against liability;
- Protect the safety of others; or
- Investigate a matter related to public safety.

Security of Your Personal Information
