Good afternoon, Wausau School District Community:

We are reaching out to let you know that our Elementary Facility Plan Citizen Task Force met for the fourth time on September 11, 2024. As another reminder, this is part of the Wausau School District/Board's process to create a long-range elementary school facilities plan. That plan will focus, in particular, on whether the number of elementary schools in the Wausau School District should be reduced and if so, then how, where, and when.

Facilitating the process is Mark Roffers from MDRoffers Consulting, LLC – a school facility planning, projections, and facility planning firm.
