The CAIU provides programs to our 24 member school districts: Big Spring, Camp Hill, Carlisle Area, Central Dauphin, Cumberland Valley, Derry Township, East Pennsboro Area, Greenwood, Halifax Area, Harrisburg, Lower Dauphin, Mechanicsburg Area, Middletown Area, Millersburg Area, Newport, Northern York County, Shippensburg Area, South Middleton, Steelton-Highspire, Susquehanna Township, Susquenita, Upper Dauphin Area, West Perry, and West Shore.

## Responsibilities of the Local Right to Education Taskforce

- 1. Review special education legislation and other legislation affecting school-aged children.
- 2. Monitor and observe special education services and provide recommendations for improvement and expansion.
- 3. Discuss education concerns and provide recommendations to solve problems.
- 4. Serve in an advisory and advocacy role to protect rights of students with disabilities.
- 5. Encourage cooperation with the public and private agencies that provide services to persons with disabilities.
