School Responsibilities

Greensburg Salem Middle School will:

1. Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the State's student academic achievement standards as follows:
 - Provide ongoing professional development opportunities for teachers
 - Provide technology access in each classroom for educational purposes
 - Ensure implementation of rigorous academic standards set forth by the Pennsylvania Core State Standards for Math and English Language Arts and Pennsylvania Academic Standards
2. Hold a "Meet the Teacher Night/Open House" annually during which this compact will be discussed and provide opportunities for parent/teacher conferences as needed or requested and discuss this compact as it relates to the individual child's achievement.
3. Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress. Specifically, the school will provide reports as follows:
 - Progress reports at the mid-point of each quarter
 - Report cards every 9 weeks
 - NWEA Growth reports with 3rd quarter report card

4. Provide parents reasonable access to staff. Specifically, the staff will be available for consultation with parents as follows:
