Over the course of the week, keep in mind the following:

- **Clothing must not be perceived as profane or inappropriate (see the CHS Guide to Student Conduct for a detailed description)**
- Theme appropriate hats may be worn outside or in the halls; please remove in classrooms
- **No slippers, crocs, slides;** school appropriate shoes must be worn each day
- **No bandanas ANY day**
- Tights/leggings cannot be worn alone; shorts/skirt must be worn over tights/leggings
- **Shorts/skirts must reach the knee or below unless being worn over tights**
- No crop tops or tank tops
- **No full-face paint OR costume masks**
- Shirts must be in moderate taste
- Belts must be worn with pants
- Undergarments must not be visible
- **No hoodies ANY day**

Wednesday, Sept. 25	<b>Classic Disney &amp; Pixar</b> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dress as one of your favorite classic Disney or Pixar characters</li> <li>• Looking for ways to dress as a character: check out Disneybounding ideas</li> <li>• Just because it's on Disney+ doesn't mean it's <b>classic</b> Disney or Pixar</li> <li>• If you only plan to use a theme appropriate t-shirt, you can wear jeans with no rips, tears, or holes.</li> </ul>
