- The 5-Star Student app is designed to reward you for your engagement and positive behavior at school.
- You do not have to have the app on your phone to earn points! You can login to the website with your school email. Your teacher can access your information without the app.

HOW TO DOWNLOAD 5 STAR

SCHOOL-WIDE EXPECTATIONS

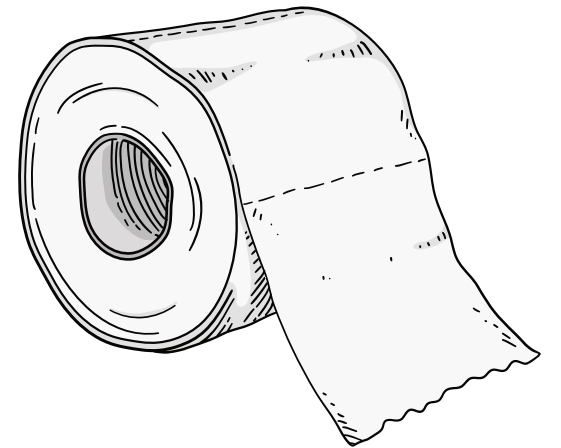
PHONE BOXES

- Cell phones are no longer allowed to be on your person during the class period
- Each classroom has a box where you are to put your phone at the beginning of each class period
- Phones are to remain in the box for the duration of the class period
- There will be progressive discipline should student choose not to comply with the phone box protocol



BATHROOM POLICY

- Sign out on teacher's sheet and take the appropriate pass with you
- You are to use the bathroom where your classroom is assigned (stay in your zone)
- The trip to the bathroom should be completed within 10 minutes
- If you do not return to the classroom in 10 minutes or less, you will be considered cut and be assigned Saturday school or in-school suspension



TARDIES

- Tardies are determined by each department (see department expectations)
- If you are tardy to SIX periods you will be placed on a tardy warning
- If you are tardy to TWELVE periods you will be placed on a tardy contract
- If you are tardy to FIFTEEN periods your off-campus pass will be revoked
- Disciplinary action will occur in increments of FIVE periods (Saturday School, In-School Suspension, etc.) starting at 15 tardies.
