Early Admission Agreement and Checklist

The Early Admission Program provides opportunities for eligible students to enroll in college prior to high school graduation. When students are accepted for admission to an approved college or university prior to the completion of high school, some college level credits can be used to satisfy high school graduation requirements. Upon successful completion of all graduation requirements, students will earn a high school diploma and may attend commencement exercises with their high school.

Qualifications - student must have:

- 1. GPA of 3.2 or higher (PBSC only) 3.8 for FAU
- 2. Successfully completed six semesters at the high school level in grades 9-11.
- 3. Been accepted by an approved college or university as a full time student.
- 4. College Ready test scores
- 5. The approval of their high school principal or designee.
