School Self-Assessment for Determining Grades under the Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights Act

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Overview



The Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) is required by state law to grade each public school and school district's efforts to implement the Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights Act (ABR) (N.J.S.A. 18A:17- 46).

Each school, is required to evaluate its implementation of the ABR from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024 by using the Self-Assessment. The Self-Assessment tool includes eight core elements that address the ABR requirements for schools. The SS/SCT must assign a rating for each indicator based on the criteria and available documentation.
