Please ensure we are following the procedures below:

- 1. ALL visitors MUST report to the main office and sign in.
- 2. All visitors must have permission from the principal, coordinating teacher, or secretary prior to proceeding into the building.
- 3. Visitors MUST wear a visitor pass.
- 4. The building principal must approve all volunteers. Every volunteer must complete a volunteer application form.
- 5. All doors will be locked, expect the outside main entrance door where there is a set of double doors to enter the building.
- 6. Students arriving after 9:20am will need to be walked to the main office, have a note ready, and signed in with Mrs. Farr.
- 7. We have a School Peace Office (SPO) present at Hart's Hill Elementary every day. Office Bob Giruzzi and Officer Clay Bramhall they are outstanding and assist with both Fire Drills and Lockdown Drills.
- 8. Raptor Visitor Management System The Raptor System enhances school security by reading a visitors drivers license (or approved government issued I.D.), comparing information against a sex offender database to alert school administration if a match is found.

Elementary Handbook

The Elementary Handbook outlines policies and procedures for all elementary schools in the Whitesboro CSD. All kindergarten students, and those new to the district have received a copy of the handbook. Please be sure to familiarize yourself with important policies, procedures, and expectations.

Building Safety Assembly

September 17, 2024

Students in grades K-5 participated in a school safety assembly led by district administrators, including Mr. Russo, Mr. Muller, Mr. Cleveland, and Mr. Storsberg. The assembly focused on the importance of practicing emergency drills, preparing for them, and understanding key terms such as fire drills, lockdowns, and SHELL terminology. Students engaged in an interactive

presentation, where they had the opportunity to ask and answer questions and interact with the administration.
