LATE BUS SCHEDULE FOR THE 2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR

Bristol-Plymouth provides late bus transportation, when feasible to do so, to students who have remained at school for approved reasons. The late bus brings students to central locations in each of the sending communities. The late bus-leaves the school at 5:30 p.m.

Students are eligible to ride the late bus if they have stayed for homework help, clubs, to participate in athletics and MCAS after-school programs. Students who have served detention are not eligible. Passes (obtained from a teacher or coach) are required to be admitted to the bus.
