Being a SAHM, it's nice to have interaction with someone else besides my son. I love my son, but it can be isolating raising a child at home. We don't have friends or family nearby.

We love visiting with our parent educator and learning about our children's development. She is always so encouraging and a wonderful listener. She celebrates our family and has helped us feel like confident parents.

Getting to talk with another parent to share our experiences and get reassurance. Also having another person besides our pediatrician helps us make sure our kid's development is on track.

As a first-time mom, I have no idea what I'm doing or what my baby should be doing. It has been very helpful going over the milestones that he should be reaching.

Our family absolutely loved the monthly meetings with our parent educator - she was so helpful, and we will miss her. We also loved going to the play center.

My child is developing typically so there is nothing particularly worrisome for us.

Having a second set of eyes on my child to help determine and interpret milestones.

Our parent educator has provided so many resources to us. She has helped us to navigate challenging aggressive behaviors, picky eating, potty training, and regulating emotions. We have learned great ways to help our toddler learn and how to help him grow.

The direct monthly connection with the parent educator is invaluable. Someone in our corner to help us out with anything we might need to make us better parents for our children.

Giving us ideas and suggestions on how to better interact with the baby, for us as parents and for his older sisters. It's also been super helpful to us as parents for learning how to communicate better with all of our kids, and how to get the baby to communicate his wants and needs effectively.

Our parent educator is so helpful at providing research handouts/suggestions to things we should have the kids work on. She is a wealth of knowledge, and it has really eased my anxiety. All of the events and the play center are so helpful and fun as well!

The program is helpful in thinking about different strategies when one strategy isn't having the desired effect. It is also helpful to have a neutral third party to give insight that we might miss as parents because we are with the child at all times.
