## General Dance Rules:

1. **Guest Policy:** Students may bring one guest (of the opposite sex) from another school. A completed Guest Pass Contract, available in the Dean's Office, must be submitted by Monday, September 30, 2024. All guests must adhere to JSerra's standards for dress, grooming, and behavior.
2. **Event Entry and Exit:** For safety reasons, students must enter the dance upon arrival; loitering in the parking lot is not permitted. No students will be admitted after 8:00 pm and they may not leave until 9:30 pm unless prior arrangements have been made with the Dean. Once a student leaves the event, re-entry is not permitted. Students may not loiter on the venue grounds or in the parking lot.
3. **School Regulations:** All JSerra regulations apply to the Homecoming Dance as it is a school-sponsored event.
4. **Substance-Free Policy:** Students must be tobacco, drug, and alcohol-free. All students will be checked for unauthorized substances before entering the dance area, including purse/bag searches. Students refusing searches or suspected of being under the influence will face evaluation and possible field sobriety testing.
5. **Vehicle and Bus Searches:** Vehicles in the parking and drop-off areas may be searched. The driver and passengers will be held accountable for any unauthorized or illegal substances. Buses will also be searched upon arrival. If students on a bus are not attending the dance, parents will be contacted to pick them up immediately.
6. **Dance Behavior:** Lewd or inappropriate dancing will result in removal from the event and may impact eligibility for future dances for the remainder of the school year.

## Dress Code:

Students and guests must adhere to the following semi-formal attire guidelines to be admitted. Alterations to attire after entry will result in parents being called to pick up the student immediately. Shirts and shoes must remain on throughout the dance. **Students who are in violation of the Dress Code will not be permitted to enter the dance and their parents will be contacted.** No refunds will be issued to students or guests who are denied entry to the dance.

## Boys:

1. Dress slacks and a dress shirt.
2. Sport coat/blazer (optional).
3. Torn or ripped apparel is prohibited.
4. All JSerra grooming standards apply. Facial hair is not allowed.
5. Earrings are not permitted.
6. Athletic shoes are acceptable.

## Girls:

1. Floor-length or knee-length dresses/skirts only. No high-low dresses above the knee.
2. No visible cleavage or undergarments.
3. No backless apparel, cutouts, or bare midriffs.
4. No lace dresses with nude underlay.
5. No slits or body-forming/stretchy materials like Lycra or spandex.
6. Athletic shoes are acceptable.

Girls with concerns about their attire may submit a picture to Mrs. Desmond at [bdesmond@jserra.org](mailto:bdesmond@jserra.org) for approval before the event.

Final decisions on appropriate attire will be made by the Deans or other school administrators.
