Professional Positions for 2024-2025:

Act 89 Special Education Teacher (Central and East Regions) REVISED 9/19/2024

Full-time (185 days) professional collective bargaining unit positions with salary and benefits per the collective bargaining agreement. Reading and math intervention instruction in non-public schools in the Central and East regions of the IU. Requires valid certification/licensure in PA for K-6 Elementary Education and Special Education Teacher. Preference to individual with certification as a reading specialist and/or a strong background in math and/or reading remedial instruction.

General Responsibilities include (but are not limited to): teaching specially designed instruction and developmentally appropriate instruction for non-exceptional children enrolled in the non-public schools, assessment and identification of student needs, knowledge of special education regulations, good communication – both oral and written, interpersonal skills, and competence in related technology. Position also includes coordinating with RIU6, service providers, families, and school district personnel to meet the needs of each individual learner, providing the best care, safety, welfare, and security of students.

Mental Health Worker (IU Wide) (Posted 9/5/2024)

Full-time (185-day) professional collective bargaining unit position with salary and benefits as per the collective bargaining agreement. Requires a Master's Degree in social work, counseling, or related field and valid certification/licensure in PA as a Licensed Professional Counselor, Licensed Social Worker, Licensed Clinical Social Worker, or PDE certification as a School Social Worker. Also requires a working knowledge of mental health disorders, behaviors, treatment modalities, crisis intervention, community service agencies, and excellent interpersonal and communication skills. Experience working with children within the public school setting preferred. **General Responsibilities include (but are not limited to):** planning and implementing strategies to assist student in crisis; conducting individual and group counseling sessions for special needs students; developing positive relationships with students, families, schools and agencies.
