## SCHOOL INFORMATION

Mountlake Terrace High School is one of four comprehensive high schools, grades 9-12, in the Edmonds School District, and is located about 15 miles north of Seattle. MTHS is accredited by the Northwest Association of Schools and is a member of the National Association for College Admission Counseling and complies with the *NACAC Statement of Principles of Good Practice*. Current school enrollment is 1475 students. Mountlake Terrace High School does **not** report rank. Senior class enrollment is 325.

### GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:

All seniors in the Class of 2023 must earn a minimum of twenty-four (24) credits from grades nine through twelve and complete a Graduation Pathway. One half credit is awarded for each subject with a passing grade each semester.

### MOUNTLAKE TERRACE HIGH SCHOOL CURRICULUM

All classes meet every day for eighteen weeks each semester and a 180-day school calendar. One-half credit is awarded for each semester course successfully completed. MTHS offers Advanced Placement (AP), College in the High School (CHS) and rigorous Honors (H) classes.

MTHS offers specific **Honors** (H) classes in: Geometry, Algebra 2, Pre-Calculus, Biology, English 9, & 10, and World History 9.

MTHS offers **Advanced Placement** (AP) courses in: American Government, Biology, Calculus, Statistics, Chemistry, Computer Science, English Language and Composition, European History, Psychology, Physics and US History.

MTHS **College in the High School** (CHS) is available within Pre-Calculus, Business Math, Engineering, European History, US History, Race & Ethnic Relations, Journalism, and Spanish 1 & 2.

Washington State History requirement is met in US History, AP US History.

MTHS houses the Edmonds School District's designated STEM magnet program. Students in STEM take a common core of foundational courses in 9th or 10th grade, before choosing a specialty from the available advanced pathways of Aerospace, Biotechnology, or Computer Science/Engineering. Each 12th grade STEM student is required to complete a capstone project in their chosen pathway.
