

Salon Party Host FAQs



What is a Salon Party?

A salon party is a small community building fundraising event, 100% hosted by French International families. All ticket sales go to benefit the financial aid program at French International.

What are my expectations as a host?

As host, you'd provide the venue, plan the event, and cover any related expenses. French International will handle the ticket sales and marketing of the event.



How many guests should come?

This depends on your venue and comfort level. We ask that a minimum 10 people are able to attend.

What should the theme be?

Anything! From themed dinners, wine tastings, backyard barbecues, game nights, cooking classes, and more! We have a list of ideas, but this is also an opportunity to let your creativity fly!

When should I hold a Salon Party?

French International's goal is one Salon Party per month, September to June (excluding December). That being said, the more the merrier! The choice of date is up to you, but we recommend avoiding long weekends or busy seasons, like the winter holidays.

What about tickets? Pricing & Selling

French International will work with you to set a ticket price. Ticket sales are hosted in Veracross; French International will create and manage the ticketing page, and communicate the guest list to you 2 weeks and 3 days before your event.



How are Salon Parties announced?

Salon Parties are "dropped" at Fête du Vin and the Annual Gala, as well as announced throughout the year in Family News.

How many volunteer hours do I receive?

Salon Party hosts receive 20 hours, meeting the volunteer requirement for the year.
