The Walk will move through Vienna for about 3 miles, beginning and ending at Emmaus United Church of Christ, 900 Maple Avenue East. A shorter route is also available. Water and snacks will be provided.

You—or your family, business, scout troop or other organization—can participate by registering to walk, obtaining sponsors, joining the OLGC team, forming your own team, or making a donation. Three

quarters of the funds raised goes to Church World Service (a hunger relief nonprofit), and one quarter to the Committee for Helping Others (CHO), based in Vienna/Oakton, which provides a food pantry and emergency assistance to local residents.

## Mass Setting Change?

You may have noticed that last  
week we sang a different setting of  
the service music (Glory to God,  
Gospel Acclamation, etc.) because  
this past Sunday marked a turning  
point in the tenor or theme of the  
first reading and gospel from now  
until the close of the liturgical year  
in November. Setting his “face like  
flint,” Jesus begins his resolute  
journey to Jerusalem, where he  
will face his passion and death and  
then be raised to new life. He  
makes explicit to the disciples that  
they, too, must lose their lives if  
they wish to save them. One way

we are choosing to mark this  
turning point during Ordinary  
Time is to change the Mass setting  
we have been singing since June.  
The reason is to help us all enter  
the shift begun by Jesus and the  
disciples turning their footsteps  
toward Jerusalem and all this will  
mean to them.
