







Senior Blitz


- Don't Forget! Every senior will be scheduled for their Senior Blitz appointment from September 25th-October 6th:

FERPA

FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT

Waiving your right lets colleges know that you do not intend to read your recommendations, which helps reassure colleges that the letters are candid and truthful. Some recommenders may decline to write a letter for you if you do not waive your rights.





Waive your rights and sign the FERPA to allow your transcripts and letters of recommendation to be sent! No transcripts can be sent without the FERPA!



Email your signed FERPA Waiver to the counseling secretary or drop off in the main office!

SAT/ACT UPDATES

SAT scores can be used to meet the WA state graduation pathway in English or Math


All Colleges/Universities in WA state are test optional this year!



After January 1, 2025 fill out the fall application. Check the college's website for **priority deadlines**. Bellevue College priority deadline is in mid May.

Register to take a placement test, if needed (English and math).

Meet with an academic advisor at the college to discuss class and career path.



- Bellevue College is an open admissions institution. No required GPA or test scores
- ▶ Bellevue College has a partnership with Eastern WA University and offer 14 bachelor degree programs. These are 4-year degrees. They also have a partnership with UW Bothell.
- ▶ Bellevue College offers an Occupational Life Services and Neurodiversity Navigators program for neurodiverse students
- ▶ Bellevue College offers on campus housing for students. We have housing for up to 400 students.
- ▶ Bellevue College is a great school to finish the first two years of a 4-year degree and then transfer to a 4-year college or university
- ► Bellevue College is home of the Bulldogs, including 11 men's and women's sports team that have earned regional and national awards

The Washington Guaranteed Admissions Program (WAGAP) guarantees your admission to a Washington public, four-year college or university:

- Central Washington University
- Eastern Washington University
- The Evergreen State College
- University of Washington Tacoma
- Washington State University
- Western Washington University

Eligibility is simple:

- Earn and maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher
- Meet the college academic distribution requirements (CADRs)

University of Washington Seattle

- UW has two options to apply: Common APP <u>Common App website</u> or Apply Web <u>applyweb</u>
- UW has two required essays. Students must all prepare an Activities/Experience statements.
- > No transcripts required or letters of recommendation accepted!
- > Application timeline for Fall 2025:
 - November 15, 2024: Application deadline. There is no early decision or early action
 - March 1-15, 2025: Admission notification period
 - If admitted, final transcript will be sent from Sammamish in July 2025. Admission is dependent on a strong senior year. Avoid the dreaded "senioritis!"

University of Washington Bothell

- UW Bothell uses Common App: <u>Common App website</u>.
- UW has two required essays. Students must all prepare an Activities/Experience statements.
- > No transcripts required; NO letters of recommendation accepted!
- Application timeline for Fall 2025:
 - November 15, 2024: Early Application deadline
 - Regular Decision Deadline: January 15, 2025
 - March 2025: Admission notification period for regular Decision, Early Action decisions are made in January 2023
 - If admitted, final transcript will be sent from Sammamish in July 2025. Admission is dependent on a strong senior year. Avoid the dreaded "senioritis!"

Many Private schools use Common Application

COUNSELOR AND TEACHER REC's are required.

Use Naviance to "invite" teachers to write a letter of REC. Speak to teacher in person first!

Counselors don't need to be "invited" but students must submit the Counselor Survey in Naviance. It can be found in Surveys!

You must "match" your Common App and Naviance accounts!

High School Transcripts- SENT via Naviance

Please look at your StudentVue Documents for a copy of your unofficial transcript

Request official transcripts in Naviance

Unofficial transcripts can be downloaded from Synergy

 Many public and private universities require students to send official transcripts (except for UW, UC Schools, and Cal Sate schools). Transcripts Includes a list of all classes taken, grades and cumulative GPA

All classes taken or attempted must show on the transcript

Some classes from middle school are automatically added to the high school transcript (i.e. Algebra, Biology, World Language)

Language credit can be earned through competency-based testing – however some colleges require that students have courses on transcript







Requesting letter of Rec from your School Counselor

Counselors ONLY send Letter of Rec to some common app schools (NOT UW). We can discuss in your Senior Blitz appointment

Make sure you have submitted your SHS Counselor Letter of Rec Survey/Brag Sheet to your counselor 3 weeks prior to your first deadline. Also, your Resume must be complete in Naviance

Counselor letters: focus on student's personal strengths and how she or he has contributed to the school community.

We do not use the coalition application portal. Do not request letters or transcripts in the Coalition

Not every student needs a counselor letter! We will help you decide if you need one!

What is the Senior class size?

Are GPA's weighted or unweighted? What is my class rank?

 All GPAs are unweighted, and we do not Rank.

How do we request a letter of recommendation from our counselor?

 Complete the SHS counselor LOR survey in Naviance.

How do I send my SAT/ACT scores (if required)?

Students send scores through College Board or ACT website.





Enter Community Service hours!

Find x2VOL in Clever!

- Students must earn forty (40) hours of Community Service as one of their graduation requirements. Students may begin to earn these hours once they complete their eight (8th) grade year. The hours once time, or in any manner that meets the stude his/her high school years, but must be completed participation in a commencement ceremony and a granting of a diploma.
- Community Service is any volunteer service that is done for a non-profit agency or organization. A **nonprofit** designation and tax-exempt status are given only to **organizations** that further charitable, cruelty-prevention, educational, literary, public safety, religious, or scientific causes or purposes. Examples of **nonprofit organizations** include hospitals, universities, national charities, churches, and foundations. School service is also included. All students will record their community service hours in x2vol which is found in Clever.
- Check the daily bulletin and the SHS College and Career Advisor webpage for ideas under "Events & Opportunities": Events and Opportunities
- All hours should be entered prior to May 15th!

World Language Competency Testing, Credits and Seal of Biliteracy

- ► Do you have students who speak, read, and write in another language? They can earn up to <u>4 high school</u> <u>credits</u> and the <u>Seal of Biliteracy</u>.
- ► SHS/IS/BDD/BP @ SHS library
 Test date: 1/29/25 Registration closes: 1/19/25
- ► All Schools @ SHS Library
 Test date: 3/19/25 Registration closes: 3/9/25
- ► Students must register themselves using their school email and laptop. Counselors can guide them, but each student can only register once. This is a change from previous years when counselors registered students with their own email address.






