Pointe South Middle School for Shared Student Achievement

What is it?

This is a plan that describes how Pointe South Middle School will provide opportunities to improve parent and family engagement to support student learning. How is it revised?

We also distribute an annual survey online and by mail to ask parents for their suggestions on the plan and the use of funds for parent and family engagement. Parents can also give feedback during Parent Teacher Conference nights, Parent Academy workshops and all parent meetings and activities during the school year.

What is Title I?

Pointe South Middle School is identified as a Title I school as part of Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015 (ESSA). Title I is designed to support state and local school reform efforts tied to challenging state academic standards in reinforce and enhance efforts to improve teaching and learning for students. Title I programs must be based on effective means of improving student achievement and include strategies to support parent and family engagement. 2024-2025 District Goals

By 2025, Clayton County Public School will increase the percentage of students scoring at the proficient and/or distinguished levels on the Georgia Milestone by at least 8% in each content area.



2024-2025 PSMS Goals

Pointe South Middle School students will show 10% increase in all content area on the Georgia Milestone Assessment by May 2025.
