The parents, students and staff of Pointe South Middle School worked together and shared ideas on how to develop the school parent compact.

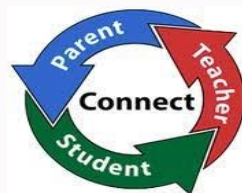
- ◆ Teachers met with their area teams to design practical strategies for parents to use at home.
