- An email will be sent from "Baker PTA (notify@membershiptoolkit.com)" to all Baker families in advance of October 8th with a link to a Google Form for each class. The Google Form will open/become active at 7:00am on Tuesday, October 8th.
- You are NOT guaranteed a spot just by filling out the Google Form.
- We must manually watch/count how many Google Form submissions we receive per class and then we will contact the families who were among the first to register for a class. E.g. If a class size allows up to 20 students, then we will take the first 20 Google Form submissions. (Google Form submissions are date/time-stamped for easy and fair verification of who registered first.)
- **Students will be limited to ONE (1) class in this Fall Session. The Google Form will ask you to rank your choices. Please only rank classes that you actually would want to get.**
