Because we are located right in school, we help students overcome many obstacles to receiving good health care – obstacles such as lack of transportation, inconvenient appointment times, or worries about cost and confidentiality.

NURSE

PRACTITIONER

- Physicals (sport, school, job)
- Diagnosis and treatment of minor illness and injury
- Immunizations
- Reproductive Health care (Pregnancy testing, STI testing and treatment, HIV testing, Birth control and condoms)

COUNSELOR (LPCM/LCSW)

- Listens
- Non-judgmental / unbiased
- Helps identify and explore options
- Helps sort through and understand feelings
- Can talk about any topic or situation that is bothering you

REGISTERED DIETITIAN

- Weight management
- Sports nutrition
- Diet changes to manage illness
- Healthy eating tips

COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKER

- Connection to health insurance
- Connection to community resources (food, clothing, etc)
- Home visits to check on wellbeing
- Scheduling and attending medical and non-medical appointments

- A parent/guardian must complete a School-Based Health Center (SBHC) consent form
- Only one form is needed – your child does not have to register every year
- There are no out-of-pocket costs to use the SBHC
