Uniform Policy at BBS Secondary

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Grades 6 - 10 For normal day to day school wear:	Navy V-neck pullover with school logo White shirt or blouse (long or short sleeved) White polo shirt (long or short sleeved) with school logo grey trousers / skirt Grey or black socks, not no-show trainer socks / black or grey tights Navy school blazer (optional) School tie (optional) School hoodie (optional) Plain black shoes, rubber or leather soles and low heels. Plain black boots (optional) in winter (during a period determined by the school) with no logos.
Grades 11-12	The above is modified for IB Grades: Navy v or crew neck jumper White shirt/Blouse or polo shirt Grey or black smart trousers Plain black shoes, rubber or leather soles and low heels. Plain black boots (optional) in winter (during a period determined by the school) with no logos.
General – for all grades	Jewellery is permitted but should not be "over the top." Rings, bracelets and necklaces – all are possible but should be discreet and modest and not to excess. Earrings should either be studs or with a diameter of no more than a centimetre. It is possible to have more than one earring in your ear but, again, on the basis described above. Excessive fake nails are not allowed in school. This is for a number of reasons. Primarily there is the issue of safety. Secondly, staff have noticed that some students wearing fake nails are unable to type properly. Nail varnish is permitted, of different colours. However, no-one should use lurid or multi-coloured varnish. Makeup is permitted but once more we specify that, if you do wear makeup, it should be on the discreet side. Fake eyelashes are not permitted in school. With regard to hair dye, natural colours are allowed. However, hair dyed in unnatural colours (green or blue, for example) is not. After PE students should return to school uniform at the next available break time. Failure to do this will result in a detention.
