Referendum Details

At an election in the South Shore School District on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, the following question will be submitted to a vote of the people:

"Shall the South Shore School District, Bayfield County, Wisconsin be authorized to issue pursuant to Chapter 67 of the Wisconsin Statutes, general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$14,750,000 for the public purpose of paying the cost of a school building and facility improvement project consisting of: construction of additions and renovations at the school building and site, including a secure entrance and office, classrooms, library and fitness center; capital maintenance of building infrastructure, heating, ventilation and electrical system upgrades, accessibility, safety and site improvements; and acquisition of furnishings, fixtures and equipment?"

A copy of the entire text of the resolution directing submission of the question set forth above to the electorate and information concerning District boundaries can be obtained from the District Clerk at the School District offices located at 9135 School Road, Port Wing, Wisconsin.

Additional Information

Acceptable photo ID will be required to vote at this election. If you do not have a photo ID you may obtain a free ID for voting from the Division of Motor Vehicles.
