Effingham Elementary School has been a schoolwide Title I school since 2004. In schoolwide Title I schools, federal, state and local funds are combined to upgrade the entire educational program of the school. ALL students are eligible to receive extra instructional support in the classroom or in other areas of the school building.

Based on input from the Title I Parent Survey distributed in the fall, Title I supported three educational events for parents/guardians: Technology Use and Addiction, a Wellness Information Fair and a Healthy Relationship event with Jason Tardy.

In addition to providing funds for educational family events, Title I also provided funds to support the equivalent of 1.5 staff members this year. These individuals provide direct support to students with academic needs at Effingham Elementary School. Title I funds were also used to purchase supplemental educational materials for classrooms, books for students, materials for an after school club, and to support student tutoring.

The feedback you provide on this evaluation will help us plan and provide those opportunities that you find most valuable for your family. Increased family involvement in education is one of the primary goals of Title I. Please partner with us to provide your family with the best possible educational experience.
