Asking questions like:

- "What was the best and worst part of your day?"
- "What is better and worse about middle school than elementary school

Keeping the conversation lighthearted will encourage sharing, provide some insight into your child's day, and serve to remind your child that although they are young adolescents who are striving to be Independent, they are not alone in their academic journey.
